## BOLLINGER

*Founded in 1829, Champagne Bollinger is one of the few remaining family-owned champagne houses. With its distinctive range of Pinot Noir-driven champagnes, the house has enjoyed a close association with Britain since 1858 and prides itself on having held a Royal Warrant continuously since first awarded by Queen Victoria in 1884.*

*The relationship between Bollinger and the British secret agent, James Bond, goes back to the years when the latter was an exclusively literary hero. Champagne produced by the House appeared in 1956 in Ian Fleming's fourth Bond novel, Diamonds are Forever. In 1973, as 007 pursued his adventures on the silver screen, the relationship reached a crucial turning point: Christian Bizot, Bollinger's Chairman, met Albert R. Broccoli, producer of the James Bond saga. Sharing a certain number of values: a passion for excellence, a sense of refinement, and consummate elegance, it was the start of a strong friendship between the two families, which was to seal the legendary association between James Bond and Champagne Bollinger which has featured in Bond films since Live and Let Die.*

## GOSSET

*Gosset, founded in 1584, is the oldest wine house in Champagne. In 1584, Pierre Gosset, alderman of Aÿ and wine-grower, made still, mostly red wines from the grapes he harvested from his own vines. In those days, two wines vied for pride of place at the table to the Kings of France: the wine of Aÿ and, from some hundreds of leagues further South, the wine of Beaune. Then, in the 18th century the wine made in around Aÿ began to bubble and the Gosset family turned naturally to the production of Champagne.*

*A true expression of the Gosset style. The highest quality is obtained from the best Champagne growths which are selected by the Cellar Master during the grape harvest. The reserve wines complete the blend by bringing a richness and maturity. Gosset Grande Réserve is powerful and aromatic with a long finish, complemented by a ring of tiny bubbles. It should be enjoyed as an aperitif or to accompany delicate dishes. Outstandingly well balanced Champagne.*

## DOM PÉRIGNON

## BOTTLED BEERS AND CIDERS

### BELGIAN BEERS



**Jupiler** 5.2% ABV, 33cl £3.80  
*Classed as the most popular beer in Belgium, this Belgian Pilsner is light with a dry finish. Brewed by Anheuser-Busch InBev at Piedboeuf Brewery in Jupille-sur-Meuse, Belgium.*

**Omer. Traditional Blond** 8% ABV, 33cl £5.70  
*Made of excellent summer malted barley from the Loire region (France) and pure water. During the brewing process sugars are liberated that serve to nourish the yeast later, giving the beer its fruity and full-flavoured character, and using three varieties of hops to give its specific aroma and bitterness.*

**Kwak** 8% ABV, 33cl £5.70  
*Pauwel Kwak is a Belgian beer brewed by Bosteels in Buggenhout. It gets its name from an 18th century innkeeper and brewer. A spiced Flemish amber beer with hints of liquorice and a slightly spicy character of coriander and hops. There is a subtle aroma of banana, pineapple and mango.*

**Duvel** 8.5% ABV, 33cl £5.70  
*Duvel is a natural beer with a subtle bitterness, a refined flavour and a distinctive hop character. The unique brewing process, which takes about 90 days, guarantees a pure character, delicate effervescence and a pleasant sweet taste of alcohol. Slightly fruity, dry aroma, well-hopped beer and with a slightly bitter aftertaste.*

**Chimay Blue** 9% ABV, 33cl £5.70  
*An authentic Trappist beer brewed and controlled by the community of monks within the walls of Scourmont Abbey, near Chimay. Copper-brown in colour with a powerful aroma, creamy foam head and slightly bitter taste, whose complex flavour improves as the years go by.*

**St Feuillien Grand Cru** 9.5% ABV, 33cl £6.70  
*A symphony of aromas and flavours, the Grand Cru is a speciality beer carefully crafted by Belgium's St Feuillien Brewery. This extra-blond amber nectar masterpiece with delicate nose, veritable cascade of hoppy aromas with hints of fruitiness, coupled with subtlety and sheer richness, rounded off by an intense yet pleasant bitterness.*

### GERMAN BEERS



**Veltins** 4.8% ABV, 50cl £4.10  
*Crisp, clean, and classic German Pilsner founded in 1824, this premium beer is still being brewed exclusively from the highest quality malt, hops, yeast, and spring water, strictly in compliance with the German Purity Law of 1516.*

### BRITISH BEERS



**Shipstone's Original** 3.8% ABV, 50cl £3.80  
*This Golden-Amber Bitter is dry, clean and refreshing. Brewed using the finest Marris Otter Malt, a perfect blend of traditional English Fuggle's & Golding's Hops.*

### FRUIT BEERS

**Liefmans Kriek Brut** 6% ABV, 33cl £4.00  
*This cherry beer is made in a unique way. Firstly it starts off as an old brown beer that is macerated with fresh whole cherries. After it has matured for a year, it is then blended with various ages of Oud Bruin and Goudenband beer. It was the first brewery to wrap its beers by hand in tissue-paper.*

### CIDERS

**Bulmers Original** 4.5% ABV, 50cl £4.10  
*Bulmers Original Irish Cider is Ireland's favourite cider. It is patiently vat matured to deliver a pure, crisp, refreshing flavour and natural character. A time-honoured tradition that is part of its authentic heritage.*

## MINERALS AND SOFT BEVERAGES

### MALVERN SPRING WATER

*Famous for containing 'just nothing at all', Holywell Malvern Spring Water is stripped clear of all impurities by the sheer density of the granite within the Malvern Hills through which it arrives, making it one of the most naturally pure waters available.*
